


Visit www.molinahealthcare.com and select your appropriate territory state. Once proper state information is loaded select “Find a Doctor or Pharmacy”.



Make sure to adjust “Plan/Program” to the appropriate plan option and “City & State, County or Zip” to prospect’s area.


Once that information is populated you can use the free form field to search by name or NPI.

If you need to conduct a general search by specialty, use the “Browse by Category” section to identify the available search options.






